Town of Indian Lake, Hamilton County: \$1.55 million New drilled well(s) Population 150

Village of Tupper Lake, Franklin County: \$6.2 million New source and wells, distribution system upgrade Population 5,500

Village of Ausable Forks, Town of Jay, Essex County \$5.2 million New treatment plant, storage Population 900
