Drinking Water State Revolving Funds from EFC**

Town of Ticonderoga, Essex County:

\$13.9 million

New sources, upgrades to current drinking water system

Population 5,000

Town of Newcomb, Essex County:

\$5.3 million

Improvements to Winebrook Hills water district wells and distribution system

Population 250

Town of Fine, St. Lawrence County:

\$7.19 million

New wells, storage and pipes

Population 927

Town of Indian Lake, Hamilton County:

\$1.55 million

New drilled well(s)

Population 150

Village of Tupper Lake, Franklin County:

\$6.2 million

New source and wells, distribution system upgrade

Population 5,500

Village of Ausable Forks, Town of Jay, Essex County

\$5.2 million

New treatment plant, storage

Population 900
